## Sun Protection Policy

The sun can be very vicious and children should be protected as much as possible. All children should be provided with hats – either the yellow Dell hat or their own. Children should be covered where possible and ensure that they are regularly treated with sun cream.

The Dell provide high factor sun lotion and every child will be encouraged to apply it on areas which are exposed to the sun, unless otherwise stated by their parent/guardian.

Staff must check any allergy forms or care plans to ensure that children can use sunscreen.

Children may bring their own cream if preferred.

Where possible the Dell aims to seek shade to play and children are encouraged to dress to ensure that the risk of sunburn can be minimised.

Adult members of staff are also encouraged to seek sun protection and may also use the sun-cream provided on site to ensure that they do not suffer harmful effects from exposure.

Where temperatures are excessively high or low we will aim to provide alternative play activities indoors and will not take the risk of causing harm by sunburn or heat stroke where temperatures exceed 30 degrees plus. (or visa versa in extremely cold conditions).
